SUBJECT: Establishment of Metro Tuguegarao (PIESTTA) Air shed and its Governing Board

Pursuant to Section 9 : of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 (RA 8749) and Section, 1 to 11; Rule XV, Part V of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (DENR Administrative 2002-81), the Metro Tuguegarao (PIESTTA) Air shed and its governing board is hereby created.

Section 1. Coverage of the Airshed.

The following municipalities compose the Metro Tuguegarao.(PIESTTA) Air shed:

1. Peñablanca
2. Iguig
3. Enrile
4. Solana
5. Tuguegarao City
6. Tuao
7. Amulong

Section 2. - Review and/or Revision of Area

Upon consultation with appropriate local government. authorities, the Secretary of the Department, upon recommendation of the Bureau shall, from time to time, review, revise, amend and/or expand the limits of the air shed utilizing eco profiling techniques and undertaking scientific studies.

Section 3. Composition of the Metro Tuguegarao (PIESTTA) Air shed Governing Board

To effectively carry out the action plan for the management of the air shed, a Governing Board is hereby created, herein referred to as the Board.

The Board shall be headed by the Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, as Chairperson. The, Regional Director of Environmental Management Bureau; Region 11 shall act as the Deputy Chairperson.

The Board shall be composed of the following members:

- b. The Provincial Governor of. Cagayan
- c. The City Mayor of Tuguegarao and the Municipal Mayors of Peñablanca, Iguig, Enrile, Soiana, Tuao, and Amulong
- d. The Regional Directors of the following:
 - 1. Department of Transportation and Communication (DOTC)
 - 2. Department of Health (DOH)
 - 3. Department of Trade and Industry (DTI)
 - 4. Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)
 - 5. Department of Science and Technology (DOST)
 - 6. Department of Energy (DOE)
- e. Representatives from the private business sector, people's organizations together with the non-governmental organizations who shall, within six (6) months from the designation of the air shed be chosen by and among themselves through concerned sectoral assemblies concerned.

The membership of the board shall be in. a ratio of, 5:2:2 (government-private-civil society)

Section 4. Term of Office

The members of the Board shall serve for a term of three (3) years (or such lesser time as may be permitted by the term of office, if publicly elected officials) without compensation , except for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, (chargeable to their respective offices) subject to availability of funds and the- usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

When a vacancy occurs during the term of a member from PO, NGO or private business sector, a new member shall be appointed by- the Board for the remainder of the unfinished term.

Section 5: Functions of the Board

The Board shall perform the following functions:

- 1). Formulate of policies and set standard subject to laws of national application;'
- 2). Prepare a comprehensive action plan for the whole area;


- 3). Coordinate functions among its members; and
- 4). Submit and publish an annual Air Quality Status Report for the air shed.

Section 6. Separability Clause.

Should any provision of this Order be declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity or the legality of the other provisions.

Section 7. Effectivity

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in .force unless repealed and revoked in writing.
