He cited that though climate change affects countries differently due their respective circumstances, it is vital to gain perspective on the strategies applied by various countries in dealing with it.



For this particular visit, the visitors expressed interest in climate change adaptation activities implemented by the EMB-DENR. To enrich the discussions, the EMB-DENR invited the Ecosystems Research and Development Bureau-DENR and the Forest Management Bureau-DENR to share their experience in vulnerability assessment and the National Greening Program, respectively.
