



DENR-EMB CENTRAL OFFICE WEBSITE LAUNCHES ITS GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT CORNER

MARCH 8, 2021 – In celebration of Women’s Month and International Women’s Day, the EMB Central Office launches its Gender and Development Corner in the official website.

The Philippine Commission on Women defined Gender and Development as the development perspective and process that is participator and empowering, equitable, sustainable, free from violence, respectful of human rights, supportive of self-determination and actualization of human potentials.

In October 21, 2011, the Memorandum Circular No. 2011 was released to address all Government Departments including their attached agencies, offices, bureaus, State Universalities and Colleges (SUCs), Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) and all other government instrumentalities as their guidelines and procedures for the establishment, strengthening and institutionalization of the GAD Focal Point System (GFPS).

As part of Gender and Development mainstreaming, visitors of the DENR-EMB Central Office Website can now interact with the following features:
