



## **EMB'S POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYL (PCB) TREATMENT FACILITY RESUMES OPERATIONS TODAY, 12 APRIL 2021**

DENR-EMB's Non-Combustion Destruction Facility for Persistent Organic Pollutants (Non-Com POPs Facility), located in Mariveles, Bataan, resumes PCB treatment operations today, 12 April 2021—after a facility upgrade with the support of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO).

The Non-Com POPs Facility was established by UNIDO and the Philippine Government. It is owned by the DENR-EMB and operated by the Natural Resources Development Corporation (NRDC) as DENR's corporate arm. Using a state-of-the-art non-combustion technology (in compliance with the Clean Air Act), it is the only facility in the country accredited by EMB to treat PCB oil and PCB-containing equipment with concentrations below 10,000 ppm.

All PCB owners are encouraged to sign up for the immediate treatment of their PCB inventories, in accordance with their PCB Management Plan. The DENR-EMB Facility can also assist in the decanting, hauling, and disposal of these inventories.
